1. What was the most interesting or exciting information you heard Sunday? How do you see that information impacting your life?
  
2. “The Son of Man came to seek and save the lost” (Luke 19:10). Jesus carried out his mission in a variety of ways. At the beginning of his ministry, Jesus quoted Isaiah to announce the nature of the work he would do. Read Luke 4:18–19. For each aspect of Jesus’ ministry listed here, give an example from the Gospels of Jesus actually doing it.

Which of the activities listed in the passage above are appropriate for the Lord’s church today? For each activity you consider appropriate, give an example of what a church (or missionaries sent by a church) might do.

3. Can you think of other needs that Jesus responded to, not mentioned in the Luke 4 passage? How was Jesus’ response to those needs part of his mission to seek and save the lost?
  
4. Of all the needs of those who have never heard the gospel, which is the most pressing?
